

SAINT BERNARD REOPENING 2020

I hope that you are doing well.

At this time, Saint Bernard School anticipates reopening with in-person for instruction. The first day of classes is August 31.

Per the SEVP policy recently released, new I20s will be emailed to all enrolled students stating that instruction will be in-person (on campus). In the event SBS must change operational program instruction to online only due to COVID, students in the USA will need to return to their home country. They will be able to continue their learning remotely and maintain ACTIVE SEVIS status.

For students wishing to remain in their home country due to COVID concerns, they may choose to attend one of our SBS/Shanghai cooperative schools options. Saint Bernard will also be live-streaming our classes. Students may continue their courses for the fall semester through our live-stream program.

Fortunately, Connecticut and Southeastern Connecticut continue to show minimal, less than 1%, new COVID infections, and no new COVID related deaths for the 3rd straight week. As the COVID situation continues to evolve, SBS will make a formal statement regarding reopening plans on August 1.
